Preparing for the Promise: Immanuel

I. The Promise of God and A Response of Obedience

A. God's Promise to Joseph (vs 20-23)

- -What is conceived is from the Holy Spirit
- -Name him Jesus because He will save his people from their sins
- -And they will call Him Immanuel (God with us)

B. Joseph's Response of Obedience (vs 24-25)

- -He did what the angel commanded him
- -He took Mary home as his wife
- -He didn't consummate the marriage until she gave birth
- -He gave him the name Jesus

II. Obedience: Our Misunderstanding and God's Design

A. Our misunderstanding of obedience causes us to misinterpret Mt 1:19...

"Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly."

-We falsely pit an obligation of obedience against the kindness of grace

B. We Tend to Believe Obedience:

- 1. Is the Opposite of Grace
- 2. Is Driven by Fear
- 3. Is Obligated to Work
- 4. Is Cursed by Pride and Shame

C. God's Understanding for Obedience

How do we prepare this season by obeying?

Let's look at vs 19 again with a very literal translation:

"And her husband Joseph, since he was <u>a righteous man and</u> did not want to disgrace her, planned to send her away secretly." -Matthew 1:19 (NASB version)

- 1. "since he was a righteous man"
 - -Where does our righteousness come from?

Righteousness comes by faith it's not earned by obedience!

- -ROMANS 4:2-5
- -GALATIONS 3:10-14

2. "And did not want to disgrace her"

-Joseph's life of faith in the coming messiah is also congruent with seeking grace instead of shame.

JOSEPH'S RESPONSE OF OBEDIENCE WAS AN OUTFLOW FROM A DEEP LIFE OF FAITH NOT A STRONG SENSE OF OBLIGATION

III. The Big Deal About Obedience

A. How Do We We Live it? (ROMANS 1:5)

- 1. Where Does Obedience Come From?
 - -IT COMES FROM FAITH THROUGH CHRIST
- 2. How do we Receive the Ability to do it?
 - -IT FLOWS THROUGH GRACE FROM CHRIST
- 3. What's the point?

IT'S ALL FOR CHRIST'S SAKE

OBEDIENCE IS OUR FAITH-FILLED AND GRACE-WILLED RESPONSE TO IMMANUEL, GOD WITH US

B. What Happens as we Obey?

Faith-filled, Grace-willed obedience allows us to:

- 1. Trust the giver of the directive
- 2. Walk in love towards others
- 3. Lead with humility that serves God's kingdom
- 4. Give glory to God

C. How do We Grow in it?

1. Hear the Word

-Romans 10:17

-How can I position myself to hear the word of God this season allowing my faith to strengthen?

2. Practice the Word -Matthew 7:24

-How am I practicing applying God's word to my life in a way that is full of faith, and grace, rather than obligation and fear?

3. Remain in the Word -John 15:4

-How might I choose to remain in the vine, who is Immanuel, God with us, this season?
