BECOMING: STEWARDS OF OUR TESTIMONY

I. What Is A Testimony?

A. A Story about change (John 2:1-10)

- 1. Just like water to wine, WE are a miracle
- 2. The world NEEDS to hear your story of how GOD changed your life
- 3. Your story is your story, it doesn't have to be "amazing" to be POWERFUL

B. Websters Definition:

- 1. a solemn declaration usually made orally by a witness under oath
- 2. firsthand authentication of a fact

C. Biblical Definition:

- 1. a proclamation. Presenting historical evidence attesting to God's unique person, position, and work.
- 2. It's telling the world what God has done in your life!

II. Why Is It Important to Share our Testimony?

Top 8 Reasons:

- 1. PEOPLE LOVE TO HEAR STORIES!
- 2. YOUR STORY IS UNIQUE AND OTHERS CAN'T REFUTE IT
- 3. DEMONSTRATES GOD'S POWER.
- 4. BRINGS GOD GLORY.
- 5. YOUR TESTIMONY (AND STRUGGLES) SHOWCASES THE LOVE AND GRACE OF GOD.
- 6. YOU BECOME A RESOURCE FOR OTHERS.
- 7. IT IS A WEAPON AGAINST THE ENEMy'S LIES
- 8. IT REMINDS YOU OF GOD'S POWER AND TRUTH

YOUR TESTIMONY IS UNIQUE: SHARING YOUR STORY HONORS GOD, REVEALS HIS POWER AND ENCOURAGES OTHERS TO PUT THEIR FAITH IN HIM

III. How Do We Share Our Testimony?

A. With Honesty (John 9:25)

- A. Don't make stuff up to try and sound more "interesting!"
- B. Tell what you know and what happened. God's work in your life is enough!
- C. It's ok NOT to have all the answers!
