The Words of Jesus in the World of a Disciple

I. Four Truths Every Disciple Must Remember (from Platt @ T4G)

- 1. The ultimate goal of God is his glory enjoyed and exalted among all the nations
- 2. The ultimate goal of every Christian and every church is to enjoy and exalt God's glory among the nations
- 3. God's plan for the accomplishment of this goal is the Great Commission
- 4. The Great Commission is not a general command but a specific command to make disciples among ALL the nations

II. Four Excuses Every Disciple is Tempted to Give

1. Reluctance: We don't WANT to be weird, or make people feel awkward

2. Incompetence: We don't THINK we are able to get it right, or say the right thing 3. Indifference:

We don't CARE that others don't have the opportunity to respond

to the Gospel of Jesus Christ

4. Ignorance: We don't BELIEVE it's our responsibility

> THE UNIFYING FORCE BEHIND THE WHO, WHERE, WHAT, AND HOW OF THE GOSPEL IS JESUS

III. Four Affirmations Every Disciple Needs to Apply (Mt 28:16-20)

The Great Commission refines our focus as disciples:

1. The POSTURE of a Discipleis marked by Jesus' authority 2. The DIRECTION of a Disciple ...is into the world with the Gospel 3.The DISCIPLINE of a Disciple ...is focused on Jesus' commands 4. The PRESENCE of a Disciple ...is with the presence of Jesus

> WE KNOW THAT ALL AUTHORITY HAS BEEN GIVEN TO JESUS AND WE LIVE OUT THE GOSPEL IN ITS FULLEST EXPRESSION

IV. Four Declarations Every Disciple of Jesus Must Continue to Live:

Our declarations of the Gospel replace our initial misbeliefs concerning the Gospel A disciple of Jesus never stops learning, relating, and communicating the Gospel!

- 1. The Gospel is GOOD news
- 2. The Gospel is CLEAR news
- 3. The Gospel is SAVING news
- 4. The Gospel is SANCTIFYING news
