I. Living in Darkness, Isolation, and Judgment

- A. Living in Darkness
 - -searching in the dark for direction and meaning
- B. Separated and Alienated
 - -from God and from others
- C. In a World of Judgement,
 - -with shifting morality, blame, and shame

LIVING IN DARKNESS, ALIENATION, AND JUDGEMENT
CAUSES US TO BE TIMID, DISTANT, AND FEARFUL;
BUT CHRIST COLLECTS US, CONNECTS US, AND CALLS US TO THE COURAGEOUS.

II. JESUS EQUIPS US TO GROW UP; GATHERS US TO BUILD UP; AND CALLS US TO LIFT UP.

Peter paints three vivid pictures:

The **INTIMACY** of a baby breast feeding

The **INTEGRITY** of a stone house under construction

And the IDENTITY of a new and chosen people declaring the praises of God

A. NEWBORN BABIES EQUIPPED TO GROW UP (vs 1-3)

- 1. "Therefore"
- ...in the light of "this is the word (living and enduring) that was preached to you..."
- 2. "Rid Yourself"
 - a. Malice
 - b. Deceit
 - c. Hypocrisy
 - d. Envy
 - e. Slander

OBEDIENCE IS AN ACT OF WORSHIP, NOT WORK.

IT'S IN RESPONSE *TO* GOD'S LOVE, NOT THE REASON *FOR* GOD'S LOVE.

- 3. Like Newborn Babies
 - a. Crave: to long for

- b. Pure: unadulterated and uncut
- c. Spiritual: from logikos- adjective form of the word "logos":
 - -reasonable
 - -divine knowledge
 - -the word of God
- d. Milk: essential nourishment and protection -the perfect food for a newborn

CRAVE THE UNADULTERATED MILK OF THE WORD

B. LIVING STONES GATHERED TO BE BUILT UP (vs 4-8)

- 1. "As you come to [Jesus]" -vs 4
 - -Jesus is the Cornerstone on which our spiritual house is built
- 2. Jesus is the cornerstone, architect, and builder.
 - -He collects and connects us as members of His spiritual house called the Church

C. A CHOSEN PEOPLE CALLED TO LIFT UP (vs 9-10)

- 1. Our New Identity
 - -A Chosen People
 - -Royal Priesthood
 - -Holy Nation
 - -God's Special Possession
- 2. Our New Glory: "that we may declare the praises of him who..."
 - -Called us out of darkness and into HIS WONDERFUL LIGHT
 - -"Once NOT a people, but now THE PEOPLE OF GOD"
 - -Once no mercy but now YOU HAVE RECEIVED MERCY

III. ...So Live the Beautiful Life (vs 11-12)

- A. As Foreigners and Exiles
 - -a sojourner- literally, someone "passing through" but still with personal relationship with the people in that locale
- B. Abstain from sinful desires
 - -waging war against your soul
- C. Live Such Good Lives
 - -even though you are accused of doing wrong
 - -they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day he visits
