Leading as a Follower: Sober Minded and Pure Hearted

I. A Life Conformed

A. Frequently Distracted

- -by tantalizing information about the past
- -by pressing circumstances of today
- -by future rumors of a better tomorrow

B. Quickly Diverted

-convinced something else other than Christ might offer an answer to our problems we quickly begin to hedge our bets.

C. Easily Distorted

-believing there's life to be had apart from Jesus

II. "Be Holy, Because I am Holy"

A. A Holy Life is a Life with a Clear Lens... "Therefore" -vs 13

In the clear lens of

- 1. What God has done...
- 2. What God is doing...
- 3. What God will do....

A HOLY LIFE IS A LIFE LIVED IN RESPONSE TO WHAT GOD HAS DONE, IS DOING, AND WILL DO IN OUR LIVES. WHEN IT'S NOT, WE JUST DIE TRYING.

B. A Life Lived in Holy Response:

- 1. With a Mindset for Action (vs 13)
 - a. literally: "gird up the loins of your mind"
- 2. With a Sober Mind
 - a. keeping your wits about you
 - b. the opposite of irrational

3. With a Hope Fully Set:

- a. on the grace promised through Jesus
- b. to "set our hope" is to believe the Gospel

"HOPE ISN'T AN ATTITUDE THAT NEEDS CULTIVATED; IT IS A REALITY TO BE RECOGNIZED" -E. Clowney

- 4. In Obedience as Children of God:
 - a. with a Father who loves us
 - b. with an inheritance that does not perish, spoil, or fade
- 5. Not conforming to the patterns of this world
 - a. Romans 12:2

GOD DOESN'T WANT US TO BE CONFORMED, OR EVEN JUST INFORMED... HE WANTS US TO BE TRANSFORMED INTO THE IMAGE OF CHRIST

III. 5 Rules for Leading with Transformational Lives..."So Live out Your Time Here" (vs 17-25)

Rule #1. Remember Your Citizenship (vs 17)

- -is in Heaven, not here
- -with your allegiance to your heavenly Father
- -in reverent fear of Him, not man

Rule #2. Reorient Your Identity (vs 18-20)

- -in Christ and nothing else
- -bought by Christ, not by works
- -for your sake, out of His great love

Rule #3. Recognize Your Hope (vs 21)

-is in Jesus and no one else

Rule #4. **Resolve to Love Deeply** (vs 22)

- -with a pure heart: "now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth
 ... love from the heart"
- -from the new, sincere brotherly-love; with a new, holy, agape-love

Agape Love is God's immeasurable and incomparable love for us. It is his ongoing, outgoing, self-sacrificing concern for the ones He created. God gives this love without condition and unreservedly to those who are both undeserving of and inferior to himself.

Rule #5. Remain Planted (vs 23-25)

- -in the word of God
- -it is living and enduring in a world that is anything but.
- 1. Where am I distracted by my work, diverted with my attention, or distorted in my thinking? How does that keep me from being transformed to the image of Christ?
- 2. How practically can I live in the transformed and holy life of Christ today?
- 3. What might a sober mind and pure heart change as I lead as a follower of Jesus where I live, work, and play?
