A LIFE OF FAITH BRINGS:
THE CALL TO PURPOSE;
COURAGE TO SUFFER;
CONFIDENCE TO WAIT;
CONVICTION TO FOLLOW THROUGH;
& CHARACTER TO LEAD.

"23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden for three months by his parents, because they saw that the child was beautiful, and they were not afraid of the king's edict. 24 By faith Moses, when he was grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, 25 choosing rather to be mistreated with the people of God than to enjoy the fleeting pleasures of sin. 26 He considered the reproach of Christ greater wealth than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward. 27 By faith he left Egypt, not being afraid of the anger of the king, for he endured as seeing him who is invisible. 28 By faith he kept the Passover and sprinkled the blood, so that the Destroyer of the firstborn might not touch them. 29 By faith the people crossed the Red Sea as on dry land, but the Egyptians, when they attempted to do the same, were drowned." **(Hebrews 11:23-29)**

II. The Life of Moses: Geared for Adventure

- A. The **Call** to Purpose (Heb 11:23)
 - marked by faith that began from his parents at birth
- B. The **Courage** to Suffer (vs 24-26)
 - grounded with his eyes fixed on the coming Christ
- C. The **Confidence** to Wait (vs 27)
 - rooted in his intimate relationship with God
 - "the secret to victorious living is to face God before we face men"* Barclay
- D. The **Conviction** to Follow Through (vs28)
 - developed by his trust in God's faithfulness
- E. The **Character** to Lead (vs29)
 - proven in his willingness to follow God

III. Connecting the Dots: Moses and Faith-filled Fear of God

- A. Moses walked in **Awe** of God's glory
- B. Moses walked in **Aversion** to sin's trappings
- C. Moses walked in **Intimacy** with God
- D. Moses walked in total **Abandon** of his own glory
- E. Moses walked in full **Allegiance** to God's authority

IV. Choosing to Follow: The Adventure of a Life-time

- A. Our **Calling** comes from Jesus:
 - who came with the purpose of saving the world
- B. Our **Courage** rests in Jesus:
 - who suffered on our behalf
- C. Our **Confidence** remains in Jesus
 - who living in His Fathers timing
- D. Our **Conviction** extends from Jesus
 - who followed through all the way to the cross
- E. Our **Character** exists in Jesus
 - who promises to never leave us or forsake us
