HELLO, MY NAME IS The Lord, YOUR PROVIDER

Who Can We Really Count On?

I. Hello my name is...

Scripture uses many names FOR God in order to describe the many different attributes OF God. With each name comes a more complete picture of

- His nature
- His promises
- His person

-His name... Yahweh Yireh

"so Abraham called that place The Lord Will Provide. And to this day it is said, 'On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided.'" - Genesis 22:14

II. God Provides

A. Background

- Moses sent to deliver Israel from slavery (Ex 3-6)
- The Ten Plagues on Egypt (Ex 7-12)
- The Exodus Begins (Ex 13)
- The Crossing of the Red Sea (Ex 14)
- The Israelites at Mount Sinai (Ex 19)
- Moses receives the Commandments (Ex 20)
- Moses receives the Law (Ex 21-24)

B. The Motivation of Fear (vs 1-3)

FEAR MOTIVATES US TO CHOOSE THE PREDICTABILITY OF OUR PAST
OVER THE PROMISE OF OUR FUTURE

C. The Provision of the Lord (vs 4-7; 13-19)

1. The Lord rains his provision down on his people
 - manna in the morning
 - quail in the evening
2. Each gathering as much as they needed, as they needed it, for each day

D. The Motivation of Greed (vs 20-27)

GREED MOTIVATES US TO OPERATE FROM A MIND OF SCARCITY
RATHER THAN A HEART OF ABUNDANCE

III. Yahweh Yireh: His Nature and His Promise

A. His Nature

1. Fear is worry over something being taken **from us**
2. Greed is working to get something more **for us**
3. God, Our Provider calls us to trust that HE will give exactly what's needed **to us**

B. His Promise (vs 29-36)

Rather than a life motivated by fear and greed, a Life with God our Provider:

1. Brings us Rest
-v. 30 *"so the people rested on the seventh day"*
2. Brings Glory to Him (vs 6-7)
*"At evening **you shall know that it was the Lord** who brought you out of the land of Egypt, and in the morning **you shall see the glory of the Lord**"*

IV. His Person: Jesus our Bread of Life

THE NAME, NATURE, AND PROMISE OF GOD IN THE OLD TESTAMENT
POINTS US FOWARD TO THE PERSON OF GOD NAMED JESUS IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

A. He is the living bread

John 6:47-51

B. He so loved that He gave

John 3:16-18
