Scripture uses many names FOR God in order to describe the many different attributes OF God. With each name comes a more complete picture of:

- -His nature
- -His promises
- -His person

- a. of God's Intercession
- b. of God's Intervention
- c. of God's Command

B. We Grow Steady With a Solid Rock Under Us. (vs 12a)

Our Solid rock is named Jesus and we stand on the truth of His word

1. If we want to not grow weary, come to Jesus

Matthew 11:28-30

2. If we want to not grow weary, dwell in his word

Colossians 3:15-16

C. We Grow Steady With an Aaron and a Hur Beside Us. (vs 12b)

Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. - Galatians 6:2

- 1. Do you have an Aaron and a Hur in your own life?
- 2. Who are you coming along side and lifting up?

IV. Jesus, Our Banner

It's in the Name of Jesus Christ that we know:

- 1. The real battle isn't against flesh and blood Ephesians 6:12-13
- 2. Our banner is actually Jesus himself Isaiah 11:10
- 3. The final victory is already won 1 Corinthians 15:55-58
