A. The Source of Peace

1. There is no true and lasting peace outside of Jesus

"do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." - Philippians 4:6-7

B. The Maker of Peace

1. God becomes a man in the person of Jesus Christ to make peace

"For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace by the blood of his cross." - Colossians 1:19-20

- 2. Since God is the Lord, Your Peace, we are makers of peace
- 3. Skills of Peacemaking Speaking, Listening, Checking Assumptions, Talking **Expectations**

C. The Giver of Peace

1. Jesus is at work to make all things new

"Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, equip you with everything good that you may do his will, working in us that which is pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen." - Hebrews 13:20-21
