LIVING FOR PEACE

- 1. Cling to what is good (Vs 9)
- A. Hypocrisy free Love

Sincerity

- 1. Agape Love takes center stage
 - love that is more than just how "I" feel
 - love that is more than just friendly
 - love that has total concern for others not self
- 2. Free of hypocrisy
 - the Church is no place for a stage... so don't just "act" loving... BE loving!
 - any action without love is a clanging cymbal. It has no value!
- B. Detest what is evil

Discernment

- 1. "And do not be conformed to this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind..." (Romans 12:2)
 - the world's pattern for love is often hypocritical and selfish
 - the only way to break out of that pattern is to spend time with Jesus
 - let our minds be renewed daily and allow Him to give us His worldview.

II. Love in Action (Vs. 10-19)

Paul's Recipe for Christian Love includes...

- A. Affection and Honor (vs.10)
 - The Church in action Acts 2:42-47
- B. **Enthusiasm** (vs.11)
 - on mission and fired up!
- C. Patience and Prayer (vs.12)
- D. **Generosity and Hospitality** (vs.13)
- E. **Mercy** (vs.14)
 - Don't just love those who are easy to love... even gentiles do that! (Luke 6:31-36)
- F. Sympathy, Harmony, and Humility (vs.15-16)
 - Do you feel what they feel? Are your minds unified through Christ?
 - Do all your friends look and act just like you?
- G. Forgiveness (vs.17)
- H. *Peace* (vs.18)
 - Whose job is it to pursue peace? (hint: YOURS!) (Matthew 5:23-24)
- Trust (vs. 19)
 - "Leave room for the wrath of God" do you trust God to take care of Everything? What do you hold onto?

BUT INSTEAD REVEAL WHAT WORLD CHANGING LOVE LOOKS LIKE

III. BUT WHAT ABOUT "THEM"? (vs. 20-21)

- A. Action (vs.20)
 - "if your enemy is hungry, feed him, if he is thirsty, give him a drink"
 - Love is a verb not a noun.
 - Our job is to bring the gospel to EVERYONE and in every way we can think of!
 - "in so doing you will heap burning coals on his head"
 - No this doesn't mean that they will finally "get what they deserve"
 - Coals on a head symbolized repentance!
 - Our job is to share the gospel, leave room for repentance, and help them follow Christ! Both for the people we love AND EVERYONE ELSE TOO!
- B. Playing by new rules (vs.21)
 - We don't fight fire with fire and we don't fight evil with evil
 - We don't fight for our rights, our freedoms, or our way. Our fight is not against flesh and blood.
 - Our fight is for the Gospel of Jesus to be spread to the world, and our weapon is Love.

OUR GREATEST FEAR SHOULD NOT BE LOSING THE BATTLE BUT WINNING A BATTLE THAT DOESN'T MATTER

- Seek God, hear Him, obey Him, be lead by Him and do things His way... and go change the world!
