B. God's Sovereignty Means He Has Full Authority
In God's Purpose There is Complete Accomplishment by His Power (vs 14-18)

GOD'S POWER WILL BE DISPLAYED AND HIS NAME WILL BE PROCLAIMED

C. God's Sovereignty Means He Is In Full Control
In God's Purpose, You Have Been Carefully Sculpted in His Palms (vs 19-29)

GOD'S PLANS ARE INTENTIONAL AND HIS WORKMANSHIP IS IMPECCABLE

III. The Response Found in the Reliance of Faith (vs 30-33)

30 What then shall we say? That the Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have obtained it, a righteousness that is by faith; 31 but the people of Israel, who pursued the law as the way of righteousness, have not attained their goal. 32 Why not? Because they pursued it not by faith but as if it were by works. They stumbled over the stumbling stone. 33 As it is written:

"See, I lay in Zion a stone that causes people to stumble and a rock that makes them fall, and the one who believes in him will never be put to shame."

- A. That Which was Once a Pursuit of Works MUST Become a Reliance of Faith
 - 1. "Not by works, but by Him who calls" -vs12
 - 2. "Not by human desire or effort, but on God's mercy" -vs16
 - 3. "Why not? Because they pursued it not by faith but as if it were by works" v32
- B. He Who Once was a Stumbling Stone MUST Become the Cornerstone
 - 1. Jesus ...boom.
