I. What Are You Seeking?

A. 1st Encounter

- 1. The Question of Jesus: "What are you seeking" aka "what do you want?" (v. 38)
- 2. The Question of the Disciples: "Where are you staying?" (v. 38) We are Searching
- 3. The Response of Jesus: "Come and you will see." (v. 39) Jesus Invites

B. 2nd Encounter

- 1. The Response of the Disciple: "One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which means Christ). He brought him to Jesus." (v. 40-42a)
- 2. The Response of Jesus: "Jesus looked at him and said, 'You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas' (which means Peter)" (v. 42) Jesus Instills

C. 3rd Encounter

- 1. The Response of the Disciple: "Philip found Nathanael and said to him, 'We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.'" (v. 45)
- 2. The Question of the Disciple: "Can anything good come out of Nazareth?" (v. 46) We are Skeptical
- 3. The Response of Jesus: "Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him and said of him, 'Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!'" (v. 47) Jesus Informs
- 4. The Response of the Disciple: "How do you know me?" (v. 48) We are Surprised
- 5. The Response of Jesus: "Because I said to you, 'I saw you under the fig tree,' do you believe? You will see greater things than these." (v. 50)

- A. Jesus is the Messiah and we are the Messengers
 - 1. Lamb of God (v. 29 and v. 35)
