Do you love Jesus?

I. Do you love Jesus? X1 (John 21:1-8)

A. Not, "Can I remain comfortable or familiar?"

1. Peter went fishing and caught nothing (v. 3, Luke 5:5)

"I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing." — Jesus, John 15:5

2. Apart from Jesus, we go back to what is comfortable or familiar on our own

B. Recognize Him

- 1. Our Need of Grace Jesus shows up again
- 2. Jesus Reminds Us of His Faithfulness See Jesus in all circumstances of life

II. Do you love Jesus? X2 (John 21:9-17)

A. Not, "Can you do more or be better?"

1. Peter was called "Simon son of John" not "Peter (which means Rock)" (v. 15)

"One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. ⁴¹ He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which means Christ). ⁴² He brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, 'You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas' (which means Peter). " — Jesus, John 1:40-42

2. Apart from Jesus, we go back to who we are on our own

B. Be with Him

- 1. Our Need of Provision Jesus has a meal prepared for the disciples
- 2. Jesus Reassures Us of His Presence Be with Jesus in all moments

III. Do you love Jesus X3 (John 21:18-19)

A. Not, "Can you love the Master's business?"

- 1. Peter was not young anymore (v. 18)
- 2. Apart from Jesus, we go back to life and ministry on our own

B. Follow Him — His Cross

- 1. Our Need of Guidance Jesus leads us where to go
- 2. Jesus Restores Us of His Relationship Follow Jesus and take up His cross daily

"And he said to all, "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me." — Jesus, Luke 9:23
