ONE THING NECESSARY

"but one thing is necessary. Mary has chosen the good portion, which will not be taken away from her." (Luke 10:42 ESV)

I. Intro: Knowing the Necessities

- A. Luke chapter 10 is full of people:
 - 1. Making the right choices
 - 2. Giving the right answers
 - 3. Serving the right causes
 - -Yet all losing sight of the ONE THING that makes it all worth while
- C. What happens when we forget the ONE THING?

WE Aggrandize, Rationalize, and Criticize

- 1. We become prideful in our own work
- 2. We rationalize the narrative of our shortcomings
- 3. We become critical of others around us

II. Preparing the Way (Luke 10:1-16)

- A. Appointed and Sent (vs 1)
 - 1. "After this"... after what?

"No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God."

-Luke 9:62

- 2. "The Lord appointed... and sent"
 - -A community appointed by Jesus
 - -A community sent with one another

B. Called to Go (vs 2-12)

- 1. Before You Go (vs 2-3)
 - a- Remember whose fields they are
 - b- Pray like crazy for the Lord to send more workers after you
 - -Matthew 9:37-38 reflects the same message
 - c- Know it's not going to be easy

2. On Your Way (vs 4)

- a- Trust God
- b. Stay nimble
- c- Travel light
- d- Don't get distracted

3. When You Arrive (vs 5-12)

- a-Find a person of peace
 - -a person prepared in advance by God, who welcomes you in, receives the word, and is positioned to open doors into that community
- b. Eat well- whatever they give you
- c. Work hard- "heal and tell"
- d. Stay on message
- e. Expect rejection
- d. Shake it off
 - 1- WHAT HAS JESUS APPOINTED US TO DO?
 - 2- WHERE HAS HE SENT US TO WORK?
 - 3- TO WHOM HAS HE CALLED US TO GO?

III. Upon Return... (vs 17-20)

- A. The 72 returned with joy ...but focused on the power and sidetracked by the spectacular
- B. Jesus affirms and graciously corrects...
 - 1. "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven"
 - a- He saw the forces of evil and darkness defeated
 - -a claim to His ultimate authority, linked to vs19

-AND/OR -

- b- He saw satan fall long ago from heaven, and was cast out because of pride -a claim to His eternal presence, linked to vs 20
- 2. "Nevertheless... rejoice that your names are written in heaven"
 - a- It's a joy that is restored in repentance Psalm 51:12
 - b- It's a joy that is the outcome of faith not works -1 Pet 1:8-9
 - c- It's a joy that stands in grace and equips us in suffering -Rom 5:2-5
 - d- It's a joy that cannot ever be taken from us -John 16:22

THE JOY OF SALVATION IS IN THE FINISHED WORK OF JESUS CHRIST

IV. Working as His Workmanship

- 1. We have been created for work that is good and Godly
 - "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them." -Eph 2:10
- 2. Good work that comes through us is the outflow of Christ's work in us

"For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. -Eph 2:8-9
