THE REFRESHING OF THE SAINTS

I. A New Community

A. The Shared Partnership of the Faith (vs1-7)

- 1. Collaborating in worship
- 2. Participating in fellowship
- 3. Contributing in mission

B. Lived out in Redemptive Relationships (vs 8-16)

- 1. The Cross frees us from the cycle of bitterness and compiles us into forgiveness
- 2. Bitterness is compulsory... it's motivation is fear Forgiveness is compelling... it's motivation is love

C. In the Reflection of the Gospel (vs 17-19)

The Gospel equips and compels us to forgive one another

- -In the recognition of our own need
- -In the humility of a repentant heart
- -Choosing to trust in faith
- -In the confidence of life in grace

D. Refreshing the Hearts of the Saints (vs 20-25)

- -"Your love has given me great joy and encouragement, because you, brother, have refreshed the hearts of the Lord's people." -vs 7
- -"I do wish, brother, that I may have some benefit from you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ." -vs 20

II. A Fresh Take on Community

A. A Benefit to Us in the Lord (Philemon 20-25)

-"I do wish, brother, that I may have some benefit from you in the Lord; refresh my heart in Christ. Confident of your obedience, I write to you, knowing that you will do even more than I ask."

B. If Community, Then Conflict (Matthew 18:15-20)

Conflict is not a sign of a dysfunctional church...it is a sign of a growing church. The sign of a dysfunctional church is when it refuses to follow Jesus through conflict.

Jesus teaches us how to Deal with 100% of the conflict 100% of the time.

1. Just the Two of Us (vs 15)

"If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over.

2. Can I get a Witness! (vs 16)

"but if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses."

3. Take it to the Elders (vs 17a)

"If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church"

4. When all else fails... (vs 17b)

"and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector."

CONFLICT, WHEN HANDLED CORRECTLY, BREEDS INTIMACY AND DESTROYS ANIMOSITY

III. The Final Apologetic (John 13:34-35)

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."
