Mission

"In the same way that You gave Me a mission in the world,
I give them a mission in the world."

Jesus – John 17:18 (Message Bible)

"The most important thing is that I complete my mission, the work that the Lord Jesus gave me." Paul – Acts 20:24 (NCV)

The Meaning of Mission

- Our word "mission" comes from the Latin word for "sending." "Mission" describes the relationship of the believer, family and church to the world.
- Mission is a comprehensive word that describes all God sends us into the world
 to be and to do. It includes introducing people to Jesus (the gospel), and it
 includes social responsibility.
- Mission flows out of the heart of God. God is a sending and going God. Being created in God's image, you are made for mission. It's in our DNA – we have missional DNA.
- Because we are the "sent" people of God, the church is the instrument of <u>God's mission</u> in the world. Many people see it the other way around. They believe mission is an instrument of the church. We may say "the church has a mission," but it would be more accurate to say "the mission has a church."

At RbC, our mission is **creating opportunities for people to see, hear and respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ**. We care about people — reaching them with the gospel. All of us are always on mission where we live and work and play, so that every man, woman and child has the opportunity to see, hear and respond to the life-giving and life-changing gospel of Jesus Christ.

Sharing the gospel is the great world-changing adventure you were made for.
