SENT to SAY **Speaking Clearly about Christ**

“The one who listens to you, listens to Me . . .” — Jesus

We are Simply Sent — Luke 10:1-3

Now after this the Lord appointed seventy others, and sent them in pairs ahead of Him to every city and place where He Himself was going to come. And He was saying to them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. Go; behold, I send you out as lambs in the midst of wolves.”

1. Sent to every city and place
2. Sent into the harvest
3. Sent in the midst of wolves

Point: Anywhere that I am with people who don't know Jesus, I've been sent there

We are Sent to Say — Luke 10:8-16

Creating opportunities for people to hear the gospel from you

A. Some people want to hear the gospel — Luke 10:8-9

*Whatever city you enter and they receive you, eat what is set before you; and heal those in it who are sick, **and say to them**, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’*

B. And Some People Don't — Luke 10:10-12, 16

*But whatever city you enter and they do not receive you, go out into its streets **and say**, ‘Even the dust of your city which clings to our feet we wipe off in protest against you; yet be sure of this, that the kingdom of God has come near.’ I say to you, it will be more tolerable in that day for Sodom than for that city.*

“The one who listens to you listens to Me, and the one who rejects you rejects Me; and he who rejects Me rejects the One who sent Me.”

Point: I'm sent to say the gospel. Some will hear and receive it; some will hear and reject it. Either way — you said it, and they heard it. (And, some who reject it will receive it later!)
