Summarizing Suffering — 1 Peter 4:12-19

4 Principles for the Sufferer

"Methods are many, Principles are few. Methods always vary, Principles never do!"

#1 — Suffering is God keeping His promises; not violating them (v. 12)

#2 — Suffering deepens dependence on God, and counters self-trust (v. 19)

#3 — Suffering exposes me as either a happy eternalist, or a miserable temporalist (v. 13)

#4 — Suffering doesn't change right and wrong; so do right (v. 19)

Suffering's Outcomes — Christlikeness

- Faith, which pleases God
- Joy, which draws others to God
- Obedience, which glorifies God
