- C. <u>Fishing</u> Followers introduce others to following
 - Contrast Peter at the Sea of Galilee (Luke 5:1-11), and Peter now
 - In what ways are you creating opportunities for people to see, hear and respond to the Gospel of Jesus Christ? In other words, "How's fishing?"
 - Are you connecting the dots between praying and fishing? (I'm guessing Peter did)
