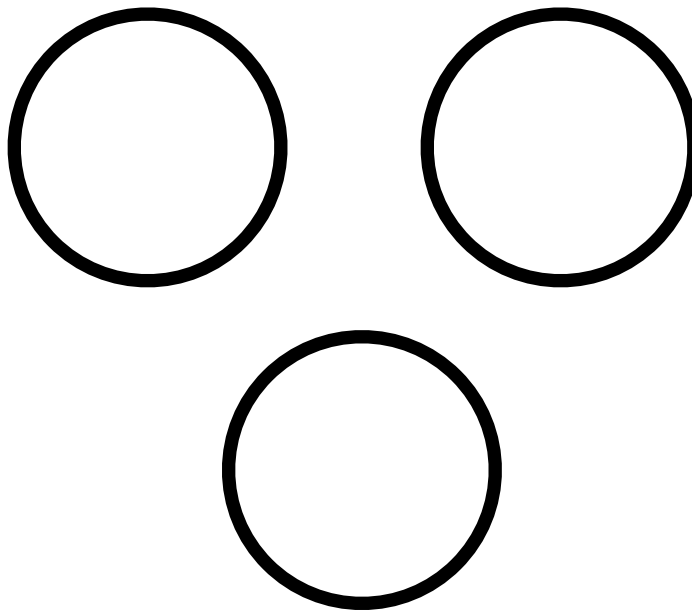

HOW A MESSAGE BECAME A MOVEMENT

I. Movements Have a Message



A MOVEMENT BEGINS WITH A MESSAGE
AND OUR MESSAGE IS ALL ABOUT JESUS

II. Movements Multiply (Acts 1:1-11)

Jesus Sends Us...

- A. Under HIS sovereign Authority (vs 7)
 - God has perfect timing and we're under his perfect authority
- B. In the power of HIS Holy Spirit (vs 4,8)
 - We might not know the "when" but we do know the "how"
 - the Holy Spirit is God's gift received not earned
 - the Holy Spirit is God's power that's promised
- C. As Witnesses of HIS Message (8a)

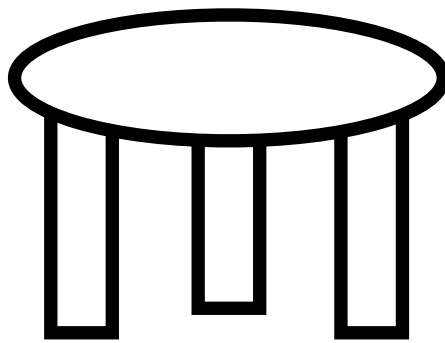
- in a legal sense: asked to testify to that which we have seen, heard, and experienced

D. Through HIS strategy to reach all the people of the world (8b)

-The Church is Jesus' Strategy to reach the world;
from Jerusalem, to Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the Earth

III. Movements are Mobilized
