Mary Anoints Jesus

- 1. **The Setting**: (John 12:1-2)
 - 1. Bethany, outside Jerusalem, right before triumphal entry
 - 2. Jesus, Lazarus, Mary, Martha, Judas, Priests, crowd, Simon the Lepor/Pharasee
 - 3. Dinner party Guests
- 2. **The Event:** (John 12:3)
 - 1. Pound of pure Nard (worth \$50k!)
 - 2. Pouring it out, breaking the vile
 - 3. House is FILLED with the fragrance...
 - 4. Jesus power AND love (John 11:32-37)
 - 5. All in
 - 6. The offense of obedience
- 3. The Rebuke of Judas: (John 12:4-6)
 - 1. Judas was offended
 - 2. The look vs the life of a disciple
 - 3. Didn't care about the poor... but wanted to LOOK like he did!
 - 4. the accuser says "you shouldn't love Jesus that way... that doesn't make sense".
 - 5. He was a thief! So is satan (John 10:10)
- 4. The Rebuke of Jesus: (John 12:7-8)
 - 1. Leave her alone:
 - 2. a "good deed" has been done
 - 3. Part of HIS plans
 - 4. Don't love stuff, love Jesus
- 5. T**he Assembly:** (John 12:9)
 - 1. Large crowds wanted to see not only Jesus, but Lazarus as well
 - 1. Lazarus was now a living testimony
 - 2. We are NOT who we were...
 - 3. WE are living testimonies of God's power and love
- 6. The Consequences: (John 12:10-11)
 - 1. Chief priests wanted to kill Jesus
 - 2. Chief priests also planned to put <u>Lazarus</u> to death too!
 - 3. We will be offensive and we will be attacked... GREAT! (John 16:33)

Questions:

- 1. <u>Do you know who you are?</u>
 - You are NOT who you were.
 - You are NOT the sum total of your mistakes
 - You are a NEW creation
 - You are beloved!
- 2. Are you ready to pour it all out?
 - Are you following Jesus with a backup plan?
 - pour out a dab, or break the whole jar!
- 3. Are you ready for the attack?
 - Pharisees wanted to kill Jesus AND Lazarus too... we WILL have persecution.
 - Therefore, put on the WHOLE armor of God (don't go streaking in just a helmet!)
 - SO THAT you can stand firm against the SCHEMES of the enemy
 - Jesus has overcome the world!
