## "DON'T BE PERCEIVED AS WEAK":

Lies of Shame and Genuineness

### Psalm 139: 13-16

<sup>13</sup> For You formed my inward parts; You wove me in my mother's womb.<sup>14</sup> I will give thanks to You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Wonderful are Your works, And my soul knows it very well.

<sup>15</sup> My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skillfully wrought in the depths of the earth; <sup>16</sup> Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And in Your book were all written the days that were ordained for me, When as yet there was not one of them.

# I. The Shackles and Cycles of Shame

#### A. How God Made Us

YOU ARE LOVED, AND YOU ARE FEARFULLY, WONDERFULLY, AND PERFECTLY MADE, SO BE YOURSELF!

- 1. We all know this in our mind,
- 2. But we struggle to believe it in our heart!

### B. The Lies of Shame

- We experience guilt for the wrongs we make,
  But when we internalize SHAME, it's an attack on WHO WE ARE
- 2. Guilt says: "I'm sorry, I made a mistake" Shame says: "I'm sorry, I AM a mistake"
- 3. When we look in the mirror, we don't like what we see, then the king of lies begins to whisper in our ear:
  - you are a failure
  - you have no will power
  - you have messed up too badly
  - if people really knew you, they wouldn't like you, and definitely wouldn't love you

# C. The Cycle of Shame and Identity Management

1. Immersing ourselves in trying to control how others perceive us chains us to a life of saying:

"If I \_\_\_\_\_, then they will think \_\_\_\_.

- 2. We search for love, power, and respect from illegitimate sources found in this world
- 3. We always come up short and are never satisfied... leaving us to restart the cycle of shame

Luke 19:7

"...they all began to grumble, saying, "He has gone to be the guest of a man who is a sinner""
