 - iv. Dam: "Love each other as I have loved you.
 - v. Matt: We do not belong to the world.
 - vi. Matt: We are to testify about what Jesus has done for us.
- 2. The Trinity
 - a. One God, three persons
 - b. If the nature of a god is perfectly understandable, that god isn't that great.
- 3. Jesus says the Holy Spirit will do the following:
