Walking With a Clear Mind and Self-Control

I. Feeling Like The Sky is Falling

A. As followers of Jesus we are...

- -called to live missionally
- -led to love courageously
- -asked to forgive repeatedly

B. So how come...

- -instead of living missionally we act fearfully?
- -instead of loving courageously, we stare lustfully?
- -instead of forgiving repeatedly, we're offended by everything?

WE ARE LEFT WONDERING WHERE THE CLEAR MINDED AND SELF-CONTROLLED PEOPLE WE THOUGHT WE WERE WENT.

II. "So Arm Yourselves with the same Mind of Christ"

A. The Mind of Christ Elevates the Purpose of Suffering (vs 1)

- 1. "Therefore"
 - -in reference to 1 Peter 3:18
- 2. "Arm yourself"-to make ready, equip
- 3. "With the same attitude"
 - -way of thinking; same insight and understanding as Jesus Christ

B. The Mind of Christ Aims our Passion for the Will of God (vs 2-6)

- 1. As a result... [you walk in a new way]
- 2. A picture of a life chasing "evil human desires"
- 3. But rather we now live for the will of God

C. The Mind of Christ Equips our Perspective with Eternal Hope (vs 7a)

- 1. "Therefore"
- -referring to: "time in the past, live the rest of your life..., the end of all things is near"

OUR TEMPORARY TIME ON EARTH IS IN THE CONSTANT LIGHT OF AN ETERNAL HOPE

- 2. "Be alert and sober minded"
 - a. "Alert": Have a clear mind to exercise self-control
 (Mark 5:15 the man who once called himself Legion was found clothed and "in his right mind" after his encounter with Jesus)

b. "Sober-minded": Sober-spirited

-free from illusion; to keep your wits about you

-one enabled to be temperate and self-controlled

WE WALK WITH A CLEAR MIND AND SELF-CONTROL AS WE WALK WITH THE MIND OF CHRIST

D. The Mind of Christ Emphasizes the Priority of Prayer (vs 7b)

1. "So that you may pray"

(NASB translates: for the purpose of prayer)

-clear minds and eternal perspective allow us to powerfully pray as Jesus taught

PRAYER ISN'T A LAST RESORT, IT'S THE ONLY HOPE

E. The Mind of Christ Illuminates the Power of Grace (vs 8-11)

- 1. In Love
- 2. Through Hospitality
- 3. By Serving
- 4. As Stewards

WE ARE MADE RESPONSIBLE FOR STEWARDING GOD'S GRACE IN THE HOUSE OF GOD

III. How we are Equipped/Armed with receiving the mind of Christ (Romans 12:1-3)

A. Is Transformational NOT Transactional

-more than outward appearances, it's the power and transformation of the Holy Spirit through faith in Jesus Christ

B. It's through God's renewal NOT personal improvement (Colossians 3:9-12)

-it's not just a lack of understanding that creates the need in our lives for a savior, it's our fallen nature

-it's more than convincing ourselves of thinking a different way, or acting

C. Occurs through the work of the Holy Spirit, NOT ourselves (Titus 3:5)

"[God] saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the Holy Spirit -Titus 3:5

D. Is Lived by Remaining (dwelling) in Jesus NOT anything else (Jn 15)

-Give Testimony: God weaves His story of the gospel through our story of transformation

-Offer Prayer: Prayer is submission, it brings us humility and softens our heart

-Take in the Word: Feed yourself daily with the expressed and explained will of God
