I. A Desire To See (vs 20-26)

20 Now there were some Greeks among those who went up to worship at the festival. **21** They came to Philip, who was from Bethsaida in Galilee, with a request. "Sir," they said, "we would like to see Jesus." **22** Philip went to tell Andrew; Andrew and Philip in turn told Jesus.

23 Jesus replied, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified. **24** Very truly I tell you, unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds. **25** Anyone who loves their life will lose it, while anyone who hates their life in this world will keep it for eternal life. **26** Whoever serves me must follow me; and where I am, my servant also will be. My Father will honor the one who serves me.

A. A Worshipers Request

1. "Now there were Greeks who went to worship"
2. "Sir, we would like to see Jesus"
3. Greeks found Philip; Philip found Andrew; Philip and Andrew found Jesus

B. One Response by Jesus

1. The hour that's come
2. The Son of Man glorified
3. "Amen and Amen!"
4. A kernel of wheat
5. Loving and loving-less

II. A Decision to Say (vs 27-29)

27 "Now my soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? No, it was for this very reason I came to this hour. **28** Father, glorify your name!"

Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified it, and will glorify it again." **29** The crowd that was there and heard it said it had thundered; others said an angel had spoken to him.

A. A Troubled Heart

B. Two Choices for a Prayer

- "What shall I say?"
1. "Father, save me from this hour?"
 - NO!
 - It was for this very reason I came!

2. "Father, Glorify your name!"

Describing Glory: to bring real recognition; to magnify, praise, honor;
to make famous

-“Father- may your character, goodness, and plans of mercy be
manifested and promoted here and now, there and forever, in
my life and in this world!”

C. A Response from the Father

-“I have glorified it, and will glorify it again.”

1. Glorified in Christ’s Incarnation
-when Jesus was sent into this world (Jn 3:16)
2. Glorified in Christ’s Crucifixion
-when Jesus died on the cross, paying sins penalty

III. A Devotion to Show (vs 30-33)

30 Jesus said, “This voice was for your benefit, not mine. **31** Now is the time for judgment on this world; now the prince of this world will be driven out. **32** And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.” **33** He said this to show the kind of death he was going to die.

A. “This was for spoken for you, not me”

B. **3 Outcomes of the Cross** “Now is the time!”

1. Our judgment fulfilled
2. Satan looses for good
3. All people, everywhere, for eternity are drawn to Jesus
